## (vi) Institutional set-up for liquidity risk management

The Board of Directors of the Company has instituted the Asset Liability Management Committee to monitor and manage liquidity risk inter-alia by way of monitoring the asset liability composition, reviewing the liquidity and borrowing program of the Company, monitoring the stock ratios, stipulating and monitoring prudential limits on negative mismatches with respect to liquidity and interest rate mismatches and forecasting and analyzing 'what if scenario' or stress scenario and preparation of liquidity contingency plans as and when required. Further, the Audit Committee and the Risk Management Committee, as a part of evaluation of the overall risks faced by the Company, also evaluate the liquidity risk faced by the Company.
